What is NECYC?

North East of Scotland Christian Youth Camps are run with the aim of providing an inexpensive, fun-filled holiday for young people in a Christian environment.

When is weekend camp?

1. **Senior Camp** is from 13th February – 16th February 2009 and is for those currently in Secondary School and who are still below 18 years of age on 16th February 2009.
2. **Junior Camp** is from 1st May – 4th May 2009 and is for those currently in Primary 4, 5, 6 & 7.

For each camp, buses will leave Peterhead and Aberdeen early Friday evening and return to Aberdeen and Peterhead early Monday evening.

What will we do at camp?

Whatever your interests are, camp has something for you. Football, table tennis, rounders, volleyball, crafts, quizzes, etc. Time is taken each morning and evening to sing choruses and learn new things about God.

How much does camp cost?
